Chantal created an online collection through VITA collections (see link to the right) and connected with the North Bay Library to gather all Nugget articles from over the years. She has also arranged with Nipissing University to house our physical archives which includes posters, photos, programs, minutes and other paper records from the Guild's many years of operation. It is so wonderful that we will have a safe and accessible space for these items.
